New QESS "associated with" RE (Cat 3)

Demand Response (Cat 4)

Storage-led? RE-led?

Resource Potential (initial potential, as evaluated by SEA and CES)

- major
- modest
- minimal

\* = generally insensitive to CPEC revenue
